

The Lupton Scholarship Fund At Wellesley College

INFORMATION FOR PROSPECTIVE STUDENTS

The Alice Probasco Lupton Scholarship Fund at Wellesley College was established in 1992 by Alice Probasco Lupton and John Thomas Lupton of Chattanooga, Tennessee. For talented women who choose to come to Wellesley from the tri-state metropolitan Chattanooga area, the Lupton Fund provides support in the form of scholarships and summer internship stipends. To encourage Lupton Scholars to return to the Chattanooga area following graduation from Wellesley, the Lupton Fund also includes a loan forgiveness component.

TO QUALIFY AS A LUPTON SCHOLAR

Lupton Scholars must be eligible to receive financial aid from Wellesley College and must come to the College from any of the following counties in the tri-state metropolitan area of Chattanooga:

In Tennessee: Hamilton, Bradley, Sequatchie, and Marion Counties

In Georgia: Catoosa, Walker, Whitfield, and Dade Counties

In Alabama: Jackson and DeKalb Counties

SCHOLARSHIPS

Lupton Scholars receive a financial aid award from the Lupton Fund on an annual basis. The amount of the award is determined by Wellesley College's Student Financial Services Office and is based on the student's calculated financial need.

SUMMER INTERNSHIPS

Lupton Scholars are eligible to receive stipends for summer internships (up to a maximum of two summers) pursued in the tri-state metropolitan area of Chattanooga. As part of its internship program, Career Education will coordinate this component of the Lupton Scholar's Wellesley experience.

LOAN FORGIVENESS

Lupton Scholars who return to the tri-state metropolitan area of Chattanooga following graduation are eligible for loan repayment through the Lupton Fund for any loans received toward their Wellesley education. Repayment is made as follows: one third of a Lupton Scholar's loans will be repaid for one year of work in this geographic area, and two thirds will be repaid for two years of work. Lupton Scholars who go on to graduate school will have a maximum of five years to take advantage of the loan forgiveness program. Lupton Scholars have up to (but no more than) five years after graduating from Wellesley College to participate in the Fund's loan forgiveness program.
