Request for Scholarship Harry W. Renz, Jr. Memorial Athletic Scholarship

Background

Established in 2004, the Fund is an effort by the family of the late Harry W. Renz, Jr. and many "Frenz" to recognize athletes attending Dalton High School in need of financial assistance with secondary education. Secondary Education shall include only accredited universities. As part of this mission, the Family encourages young people to be involved in Christian-affiliated activities in school and in college so that they might become more productive citizens. The Fund has established the Scholarship to memorialize Harry W. Renz, Jr., an avid supporter of Dalton High School athletics and First United Methodist Church.

Selection

The selection of the recipient of the Scholarship will be made by the descendants of the late Harry W. Renz, Jr., following recommendations by the families Scholarship Selection Committee and/or any assignee(s) that Committee might designate. The selection will be made in the spring of each year by the Scholarship Committee. The Committee and/or its assignee will be responsible for notifying the recipient and the Church in order that the student may receive the award in a timely manner. Award letters and any subsequent announcement for the Scholarship will carry the name of the Family in such a manner that the recipient will understand the source of the funds awarded.

Selection Criteria

The Scholarship is open to all students attending Dalton High School regardless of race, color, religion, sex, national origin, disability, age, or veteran status with the following restrictions:

The Scholarship will be available to a senior-level student who are currently enrolled or have been admitted to an Associate Degree or a Bachelor Degree program of study at an accredited University. 2. Applicants' financial need may be a factor.

- 3. The recipient of the Scholarship will have attained and will maintain a minimum cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale.
- 4. The recipient of the Scholarship will maintain full-time enrollment status.
- 5. With all other factors being equal, preference will be given to applicants who are athletes.
- 6. Applicants will demonstrate a record of community service in the application essay and/or in the letters of recommendation.

Cancellation

A recipient will forfeit the Scholarship upon failing to meet the criteria as set forth in these Administrative Provisions and any additional criteria as may be devised by the Family, the Office of Institutional Advancement, the Scholarship Committee, and/or any of their assignees, or upon withdrawal from school. Forfeited funds will return to the Scholarship Fund.
